

The Wisdom of God – definitions of wisdom

 Wisdom is commonly defined as good judgment on the ability to develop the best course of action or best response to a given situation.

 Theologian J. L. Dagg described wisdom as "consisting in the selection of the best end of action and the adoption of the best means for accomplishment of this end"
